



- Weaver verifies 80-90% of D3 RINs generated each year

- ► September 2016
 - EPA issued <u>Biogas Quality Guidance</u>
 - Pending Biogas Registrations on Hold
- ▶ Addressed EPA Concerns:
 - Purity of Biogas Incentivized
 - Blending with Non-renewables
 - Commercial Pipeline Specification Compliance
 - QAP Verification of Biogas Quality
- ▶ Did NOT Establish "EPA Spec"
 - Defers to Commercial Pipeline Spec for Project

► Certificates of Analysis

- AND Post-blending (if applicable)

▶ Blending May ONLY Correct

- Heat Content
- Inert Component Concentration

 - Third-Party Lab COAs
 - Summary Table of Results vs Pipeline


► Independent Engineering Review or 3-Year Update

- Verify Technology on Site Visit
- Confirm Blending on Site Visit
- Review COAs and Pipeline Spec
- Prepare Comparison Table



Registration - New






Registration - New



- Most common tests completed
 - More than 5 instances
 - Over 360 test results



Registration Renewal



EPA Representative, September 7, 2018:

- Current biogas guidance does not require COAs to be done every three years when the facility ER updates are due.
- Facilities still need to be able to demonstrate that they meet pipeline quality requirements and any time EPA may request a facility make such a demonstration as part of our program oversight and enforcement activities.



Ongoing Monitoring



To qualify for RINs:

- Must have in-line continuous GC to monitor BTU content of renewable gas after treatment and before blending
- ► Alternative: Develop a sampling protocol; submit for approval as part of registration application

RIN Generation



- RINs are based on BTU content of renewable gas after treatment and before blending or compression/ liquefaction
- Must document blend volumes
- Retain records showing continuous pipeline spec compliance

Compliance



- ► Failure to maintain registered processes, treatment and pathways is a violation
- ► Inadequately treated biogas
- Documentation requirements (5 years)
